We believe that a free, safe, and independent press is the cornerstone of transparency, accountability, and democratic governance. Without journalists, the truth is silenced. Without safety, stories remain untold.

REPORT Background

The SRS quarterly report (AUG-OCT 2025) highlights widespread arrests. intimidation, and political interference against journalists across Somalia and Somaliland, including violations, threaten press freedom, silence critical voices, and weaken democracy.

September alone witnessed a surge in arrests, with at least ten journalists detained in Somaliland within a threeweek period, often without due process or a formal charge.

A large number of reporters in various cities in Somalia have informed Safe Reporters of Somalia (SRS) that they feel fear when they are gathering news in the field, as they lack adequate security guarantees and sufficient protection.

Somali journalists face many dangers, including arrests, harassment, *torture, sexual assaults against female journalists and murder, which is tackling and weakening media works Somalia.

Incidents in the months of AUG, SEPT, and OCT

IN AUGUST

03 AUGUST 2025 – Somali Security forces arrested **Osman Abdullahi Mohamed, Hussein Isse Mohamed** both works **SMS Somali TV** and
Freelance journalist **Mahad Mohamed Abdirahman**.

O5 AUGUST 2025 – Hargeisa, Somaliland, was arrested journalist **Ahmed Mohamud** Dool and was released on **30 SEPTEMBER.**

O5 AUGUST 2025 – Police in Cadaado district Galmudug admistration was detained two journalists, **Hashim Omar Hassan and Hassan Yusuf Qasaaro**, after they reported on the killing of a young girl.

15 AUGUST 2025 – Somali government security agencies arrested two journalists in Mogadishu, Abukar Mohamed Keynaan from Risaala Media and Mowlid Osman works Shabelle Media after 5hourse they were released without charge

18 AUGUST 2025 – Somali government forces detained and interrogated **Omar Yusuf Mohamed**, a journalist with **Himilo Television in Mogadishu**, for nearly an hour he was later released without charge.

27 AUGUST 2025 –Anisa Ahmed, works **Dalbile TV** was arrested at **Waberi Police** station in Mogadishu after long hours she was released, there any details from the Police.

28 AUGUST 2025 – Two journalists, called **Hassan Mohamed Hashi and Faysal Abdi Farah**, both works **Kalsan TV**, in Mogadishu were arrested by government forces in Mogadishu.

■ IN SEPTEMBER

03- SEPTEMBER 2025 -The Northeast Administration Police in Somalia was arrested, journalists **Sharma'arke Abdi Mahdi and Maxamed Muuse Yuusuf (Maxamed Koronto)** one of them works Daljir Media.

08- SEPTEMBER -2025 Somali Security forces arrested **Jacfar Maxamed Jimcaalle**, a reporter, and **Cabdimajiid Cabdiraxmaan, a cameraman,**both affiliated with **Kalsan TV** in Mogadishu.

O9-SEPTEMBER 2025 The Nugaal Regional Prosecutor's Office in Puntland, Somalia, summoned journalists **Hassan Hayal, Deputy Director of Milgo TV, and Suweys Gacayte of the Puntland Government TV & Radio**, to appear before the regional court.

11-SEPTEMBER- 2025 Somaliland police in the Awdal region were arrested three journalists Axmed Sheikh Muuse Xasan (Axmed Buudhi) of Horncable TV, Cabdirisaaq Cumar Meecaad (Awliyo) of CBA TV, and photographer Axmed Dayib.

13-SEPTEMBER 2025 The Burco District Court in Somaliland remanded journalist **Cabdicasiis Cawl**, who works for KF Media.

27- SEPTEMBER-2025- Somaliland police in **Gabiley** was arrested local journalist **Mohamed Wadiin** after he reported on the arrest of clan elders in Wajale town by Somaliland authorities.

SEPTEMBER 27, 2025 Somaliland police in Erigabo, Sanaag region, briefly arrested four local reporters: Sa'id Muse Farah (Sa'id Qurbawi) of Sabar TV, Ibrahim Abdi Adan (Murti), Mohamed Yusuf Ilkacase, and Sa'id Abdirahman.

■ IN OCTOBER

07-OCTOBER-2025 – Somaliland the Togdheer Regional Court of Appeal was sentenced one year in prison and one million Somaliland Shillings Abdi'asis Awl, who works KF Media TV.

12-OCTOBER-2025 - The Waabari District Police in Mogadishu arrested the director of Himilo Somali TV, namely Ahmed Mohamed Adan and deputy director Khadar Abdirahim Ibrahim, later the police were released Mr Ahmed.

15-OCTOBER-2025 - Reporter Khadar Abdirahim Ibrahim deputy director Himilo Media, was released by the Banadir Regional Court after four days of detention, as the charges against him were not proven.


17-OCTOBER-2025 – Forces under Villa Hirshabelle detained Mohamed Amoore in Jowhar city. Amoore is an independent journalist who posts on his Facebook page the articles.

18-OCTOBER-2025 – Reporter Hibo Mohamed Mohamud and cameraman Zakariye Jinte, who work for Daash Somali TV, were arrested in Warta Nabadda in Mogadishu while they preparing a report on the Siinaay vegetable market.

19-OCTOBER-2025 – Journalist Mohamed Abdiqadir, who works for Arlaadi Media, was arrested in Wadajir district the reason for his arrest was also not specified.

25-OCTOBER-2025 – Reporter Abdihafid Nor who works Somali Cable TV was arrested police station, located at Aden Adde Airport in Mogadishu. The reason for his arrest was not clear.

THE CHART OF INCIDENTS:




RECOMMENDATION

THE SRS QUARTERLY REPORT (AUG-OCT 2025) highlights widespread arrests, intimidation, and political interference against journalists across Somalia and Somaliland, including violations, threaten press freedom, silence critical voices, and weaken democracy. Therefore, SRS recommending to government stop unlawful detentions of journalists respect journalists' rights and work safely without interference.

To reverse this alarming trend, the SRS urges the governments of Somalia and authorities to implement immediate and comprehensive legislative and judicial reforms.

Respecting the media's role is not merely a matter of human rights compliance, but a strategic imperative for building resilient, democratic societies capable of addressing the complex challenges facing the region.
